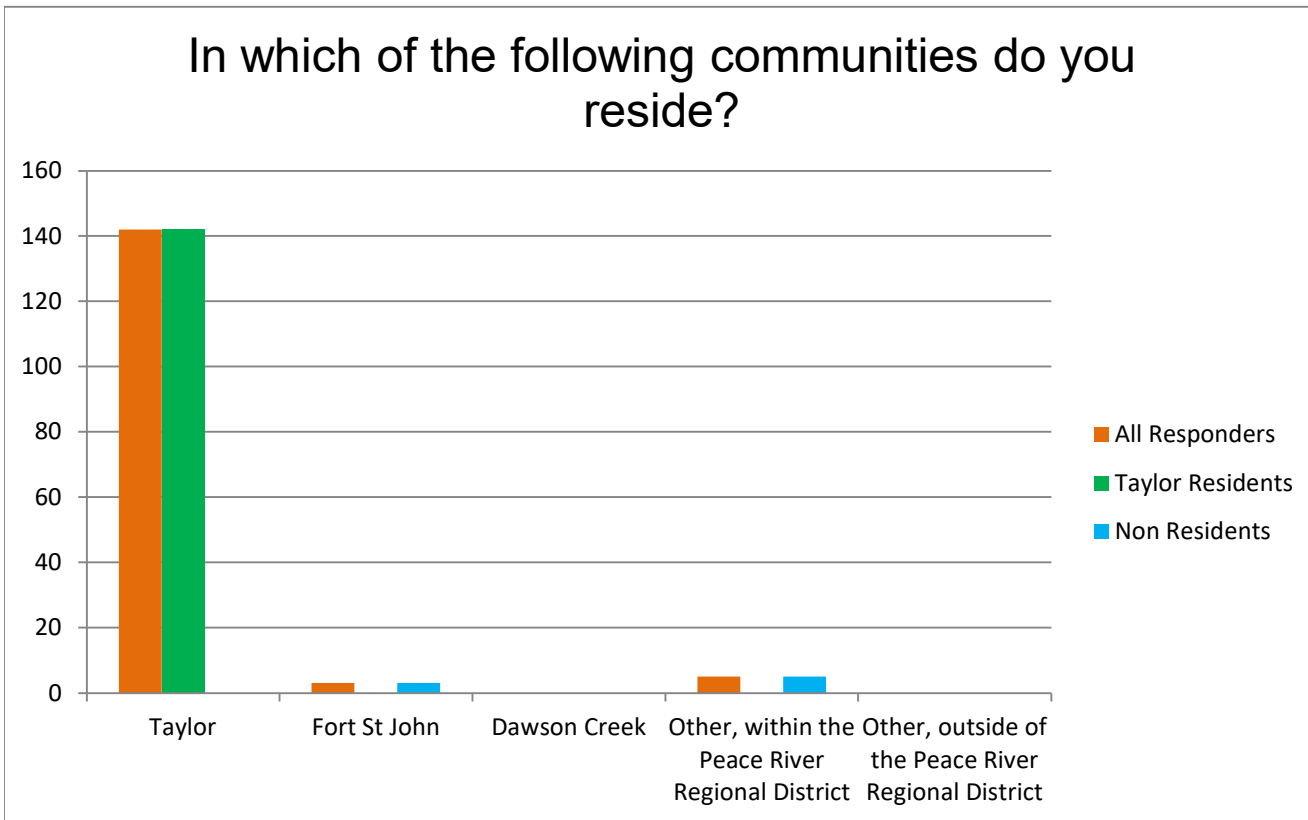

## In which of the following communities do you reside?

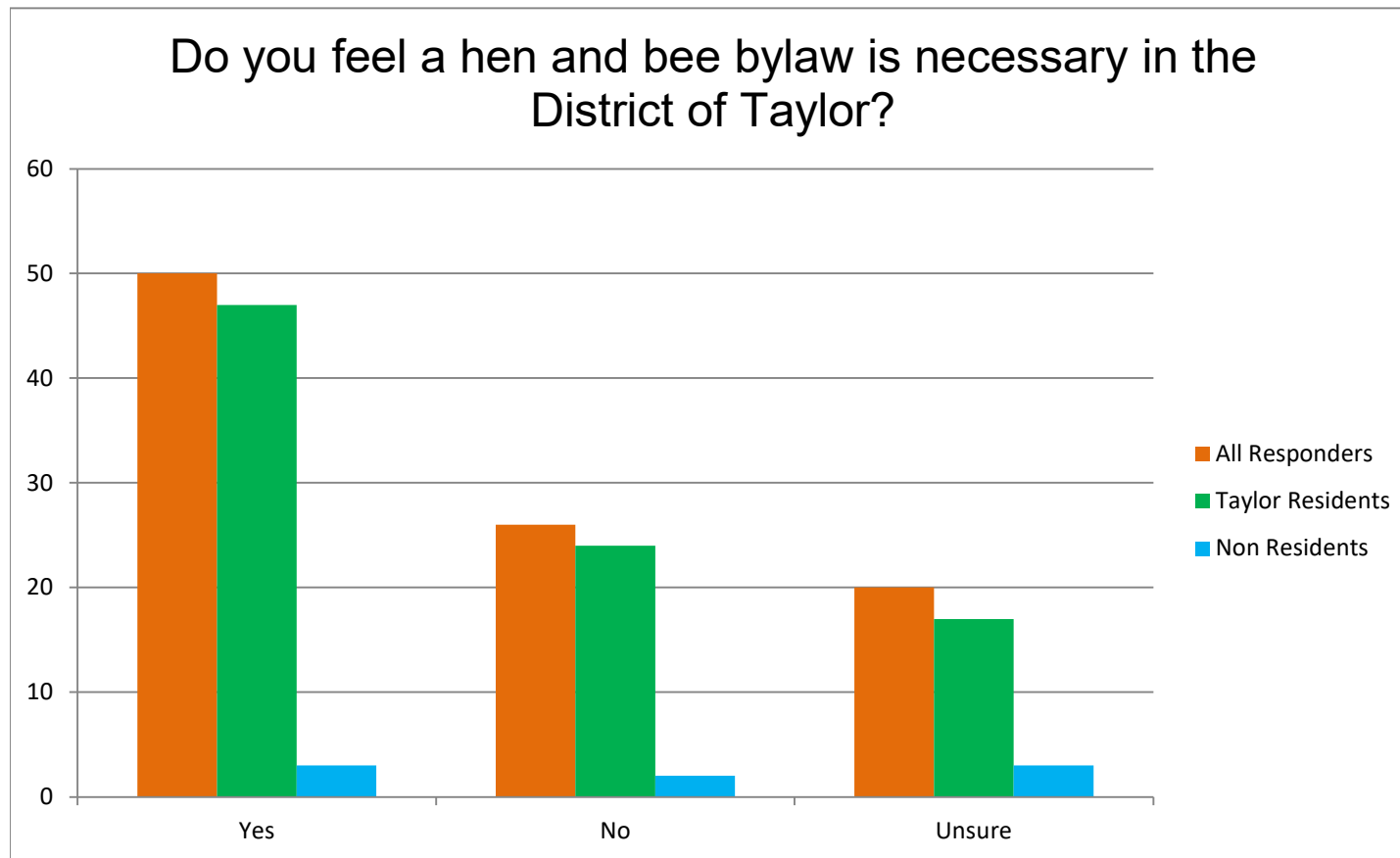

**Do you feel a hen and bee bylaw is necessary in the District of Taylor?**

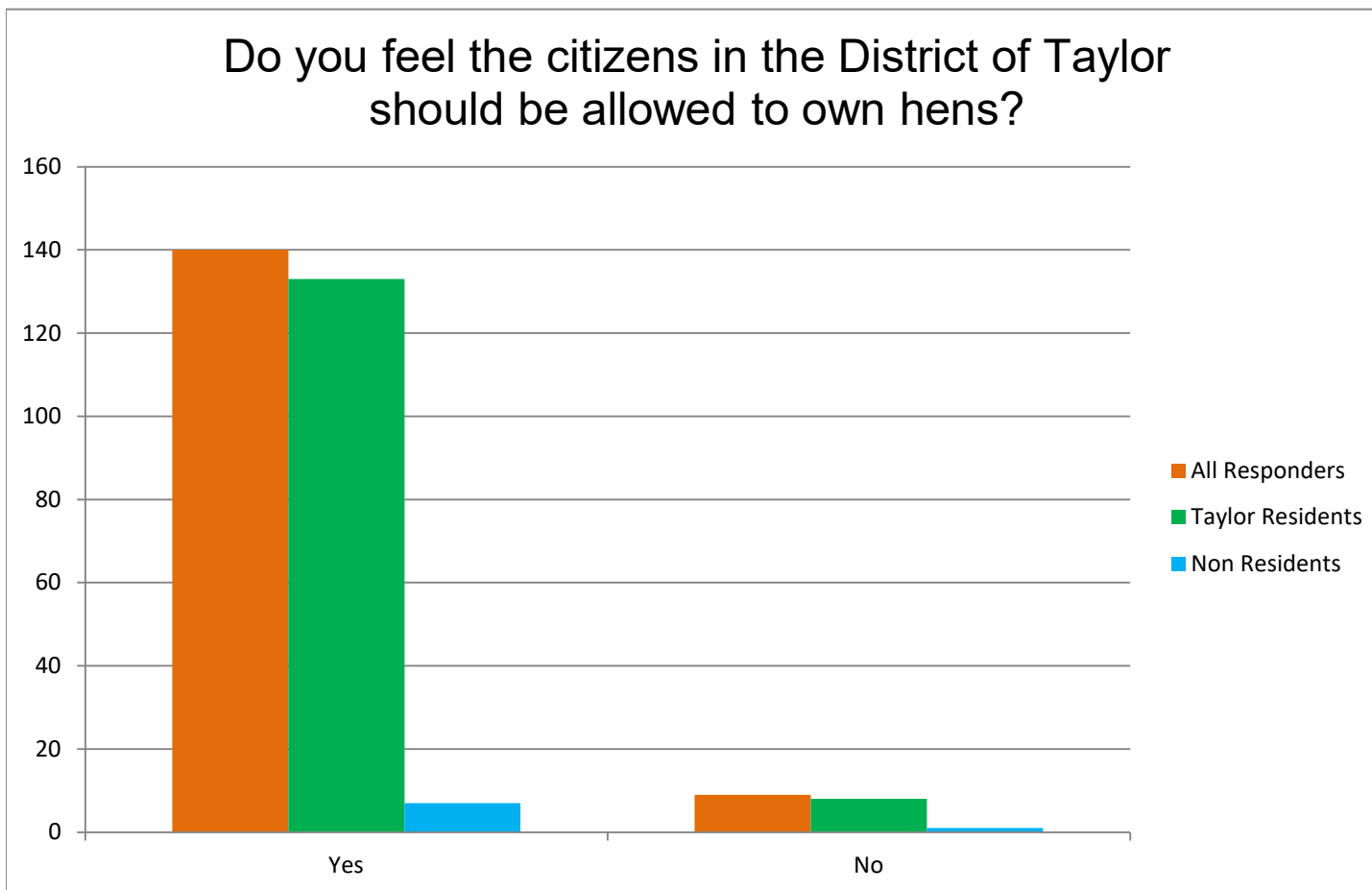

**Do you feel the citizens in the District of Taylor should be allowed to own hens?**

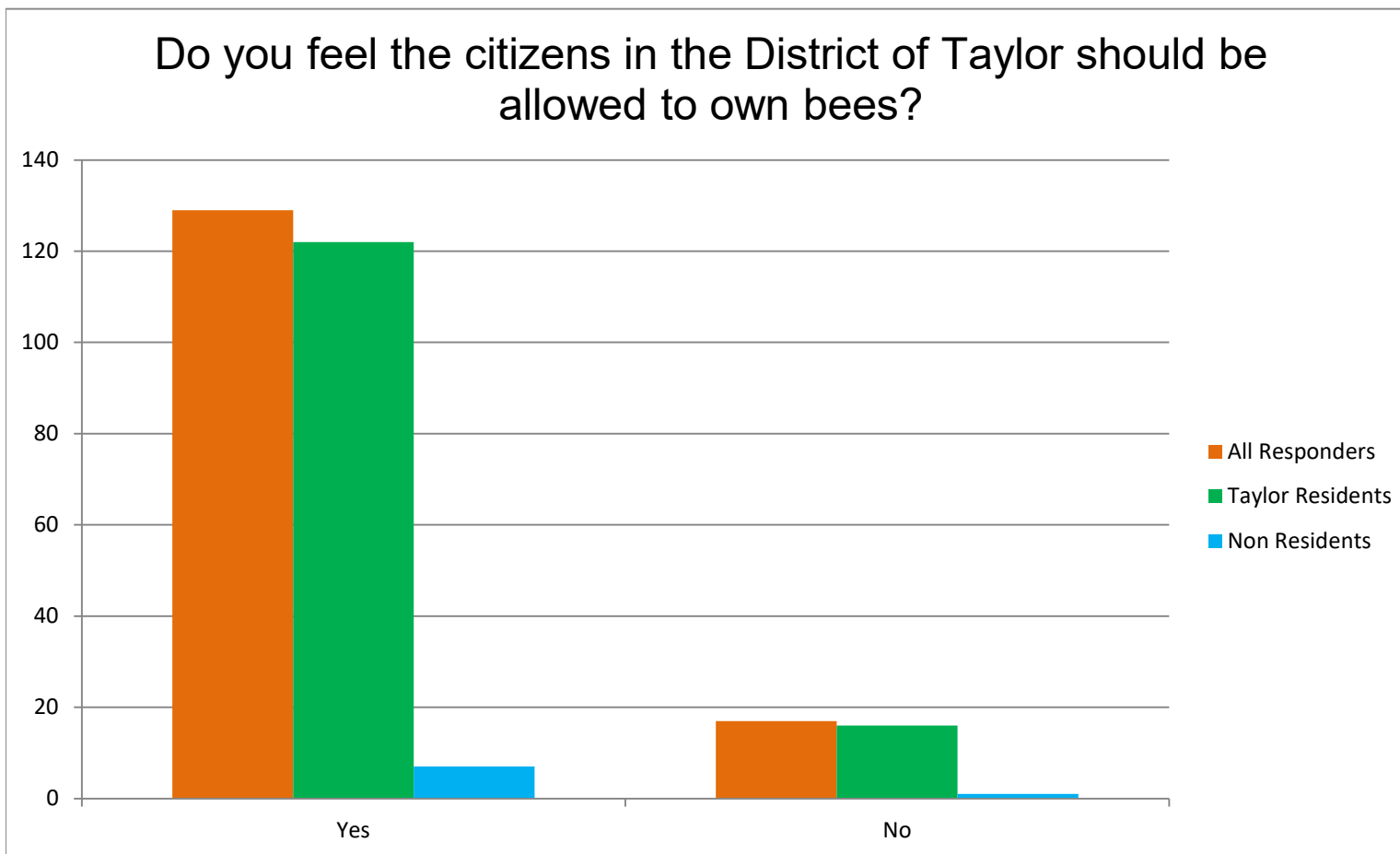

**Do you feel the citizens in the District of Taylor should be allowed to own bees?**

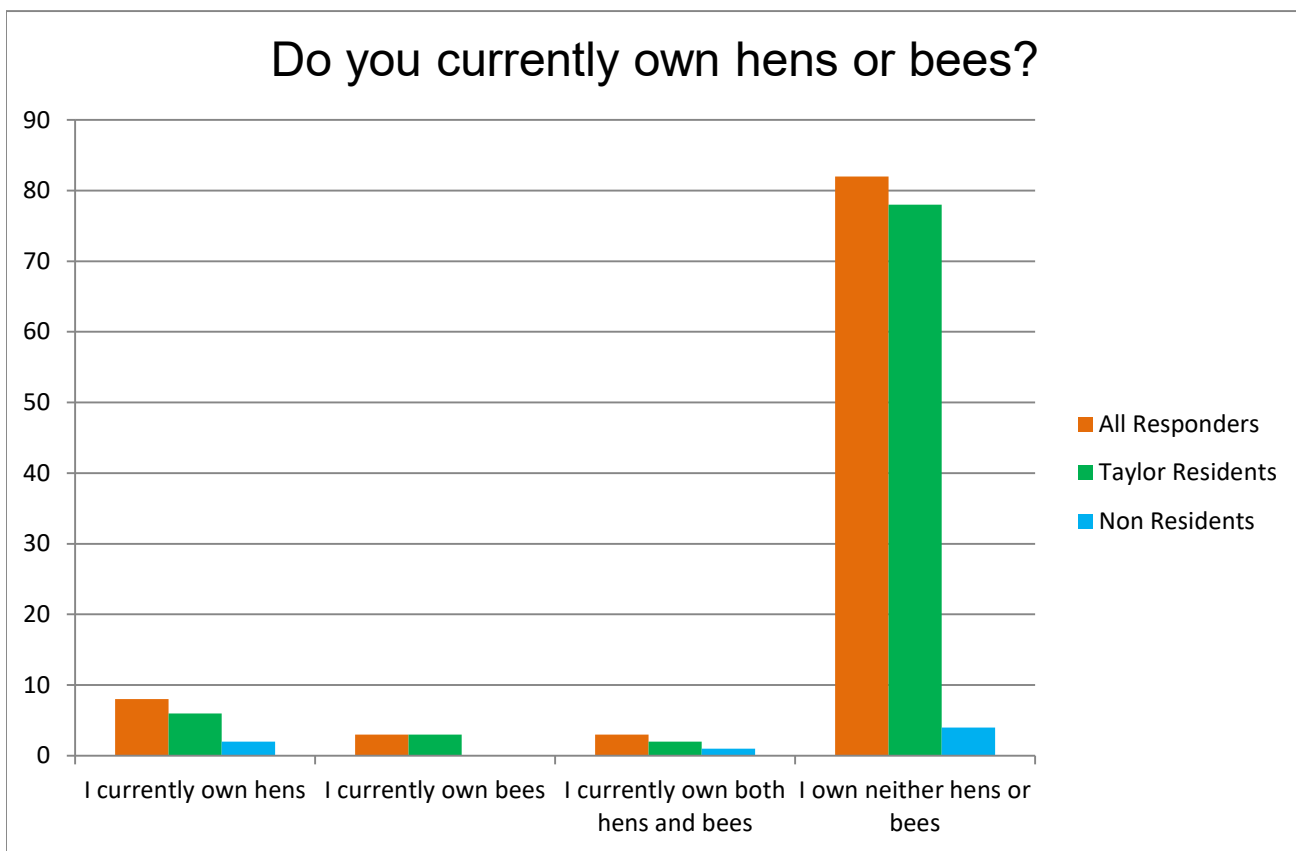

### Do you currently own hens or bees?

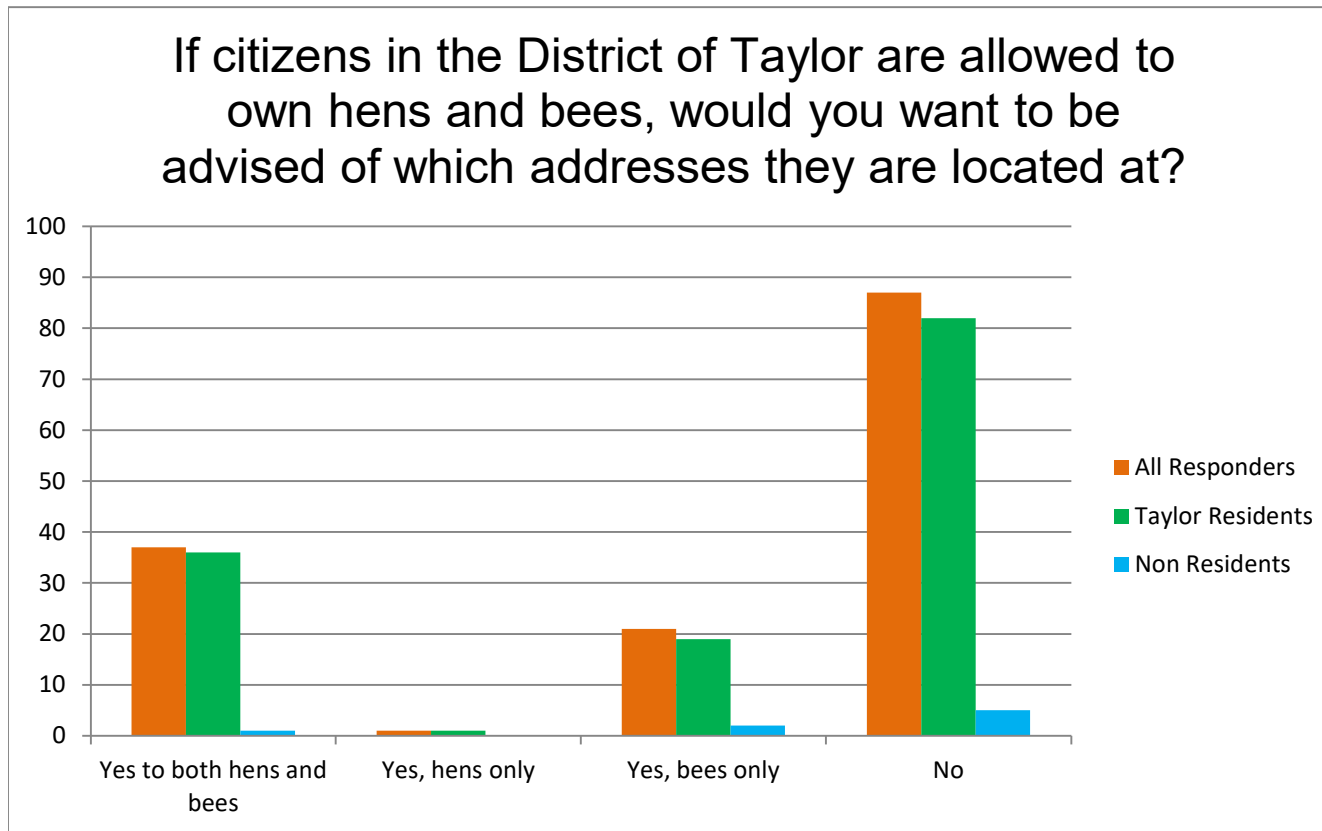

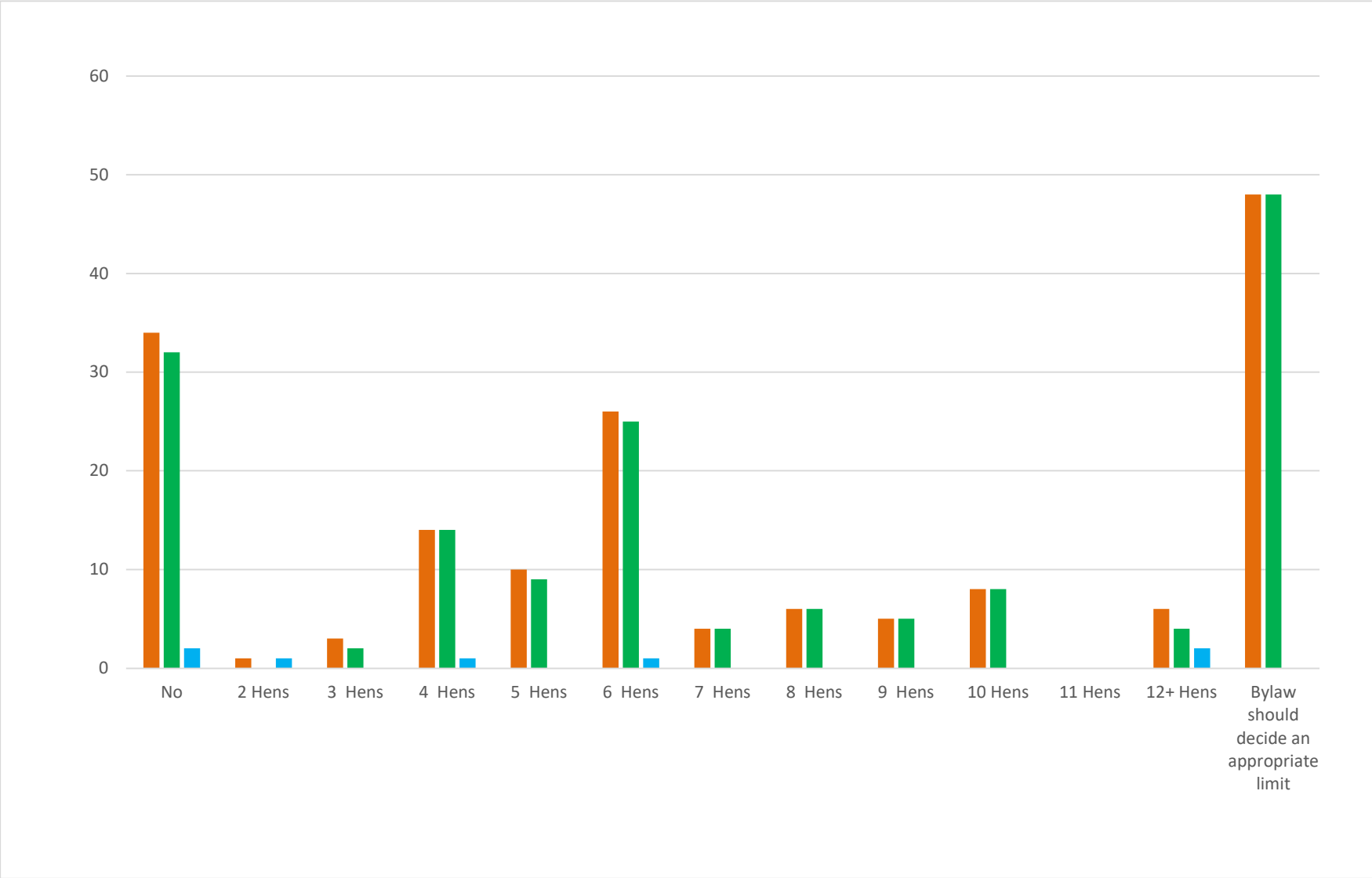

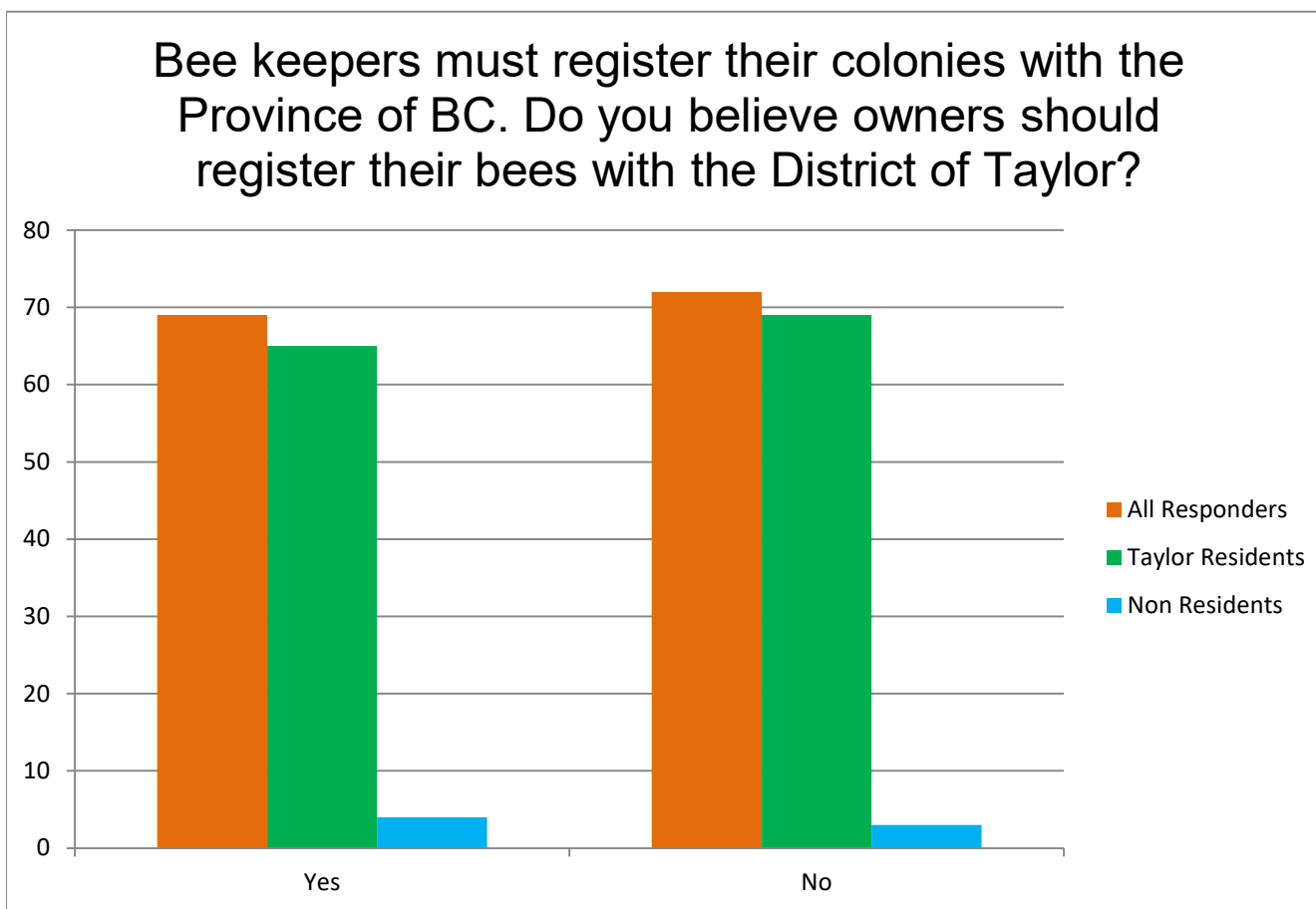




## Hen and Bee Bylaw Engagement

**Bee keepers must register their colonies with the Province of BC. Do you believe owners should register their bees with the District of Taylor?**

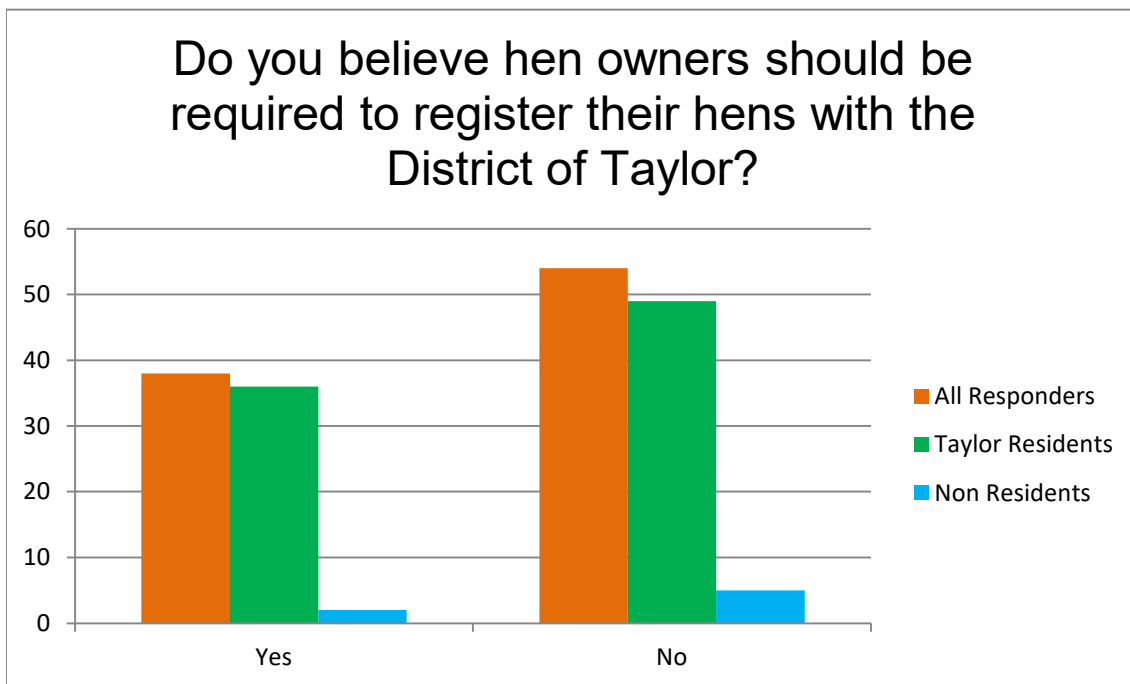

**Do you believe hen owners should be required to register their hens with the District of Taylor?**

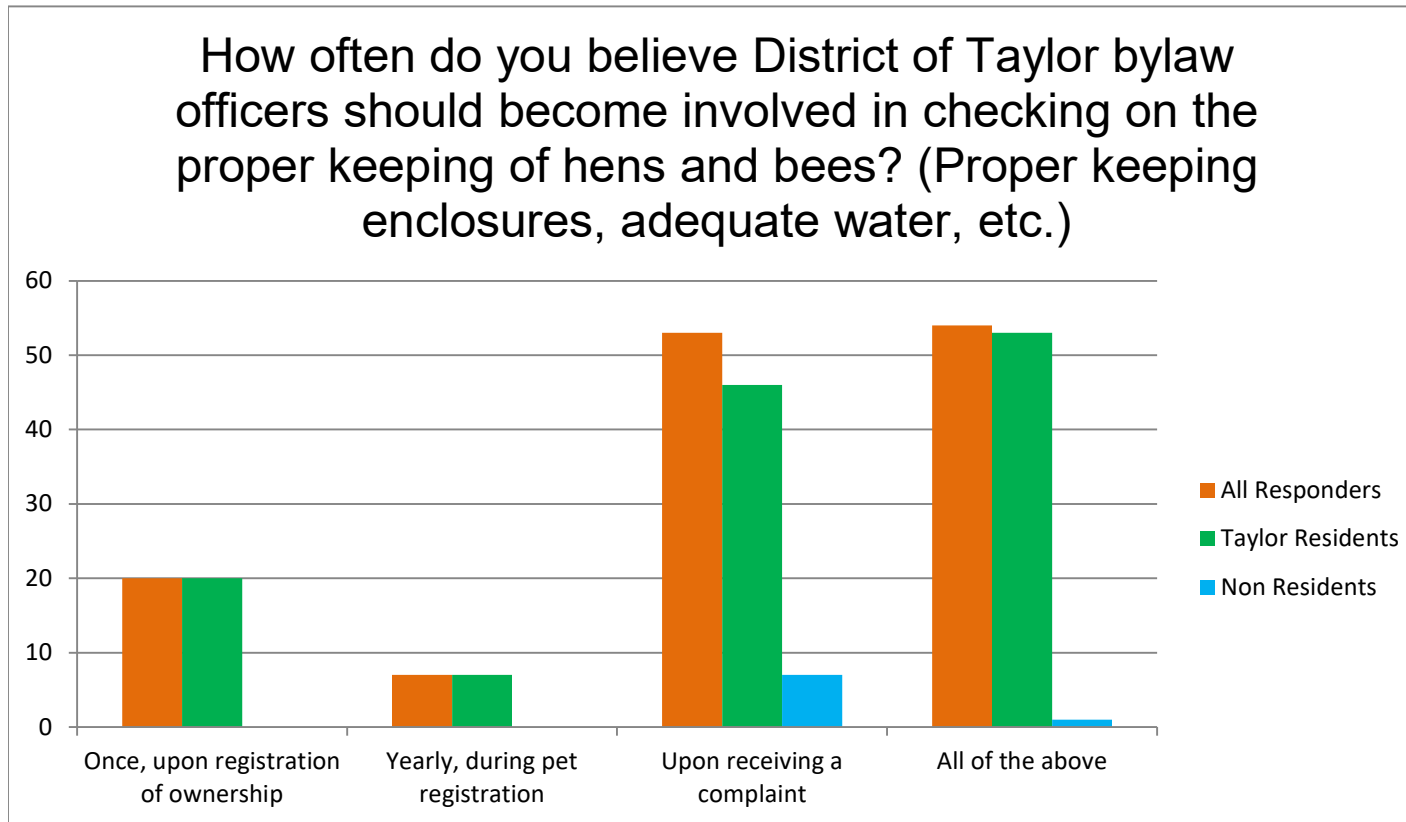

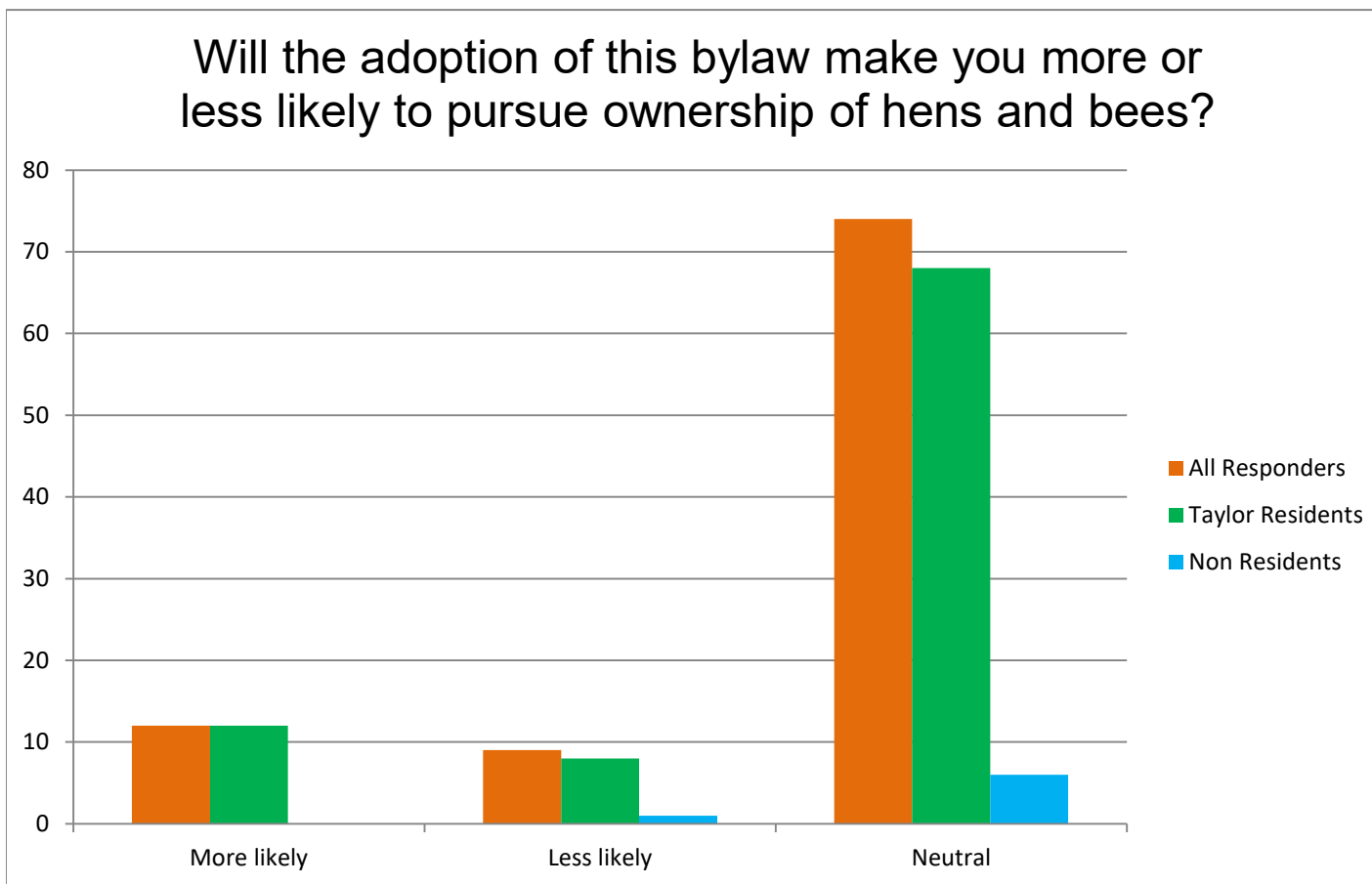
