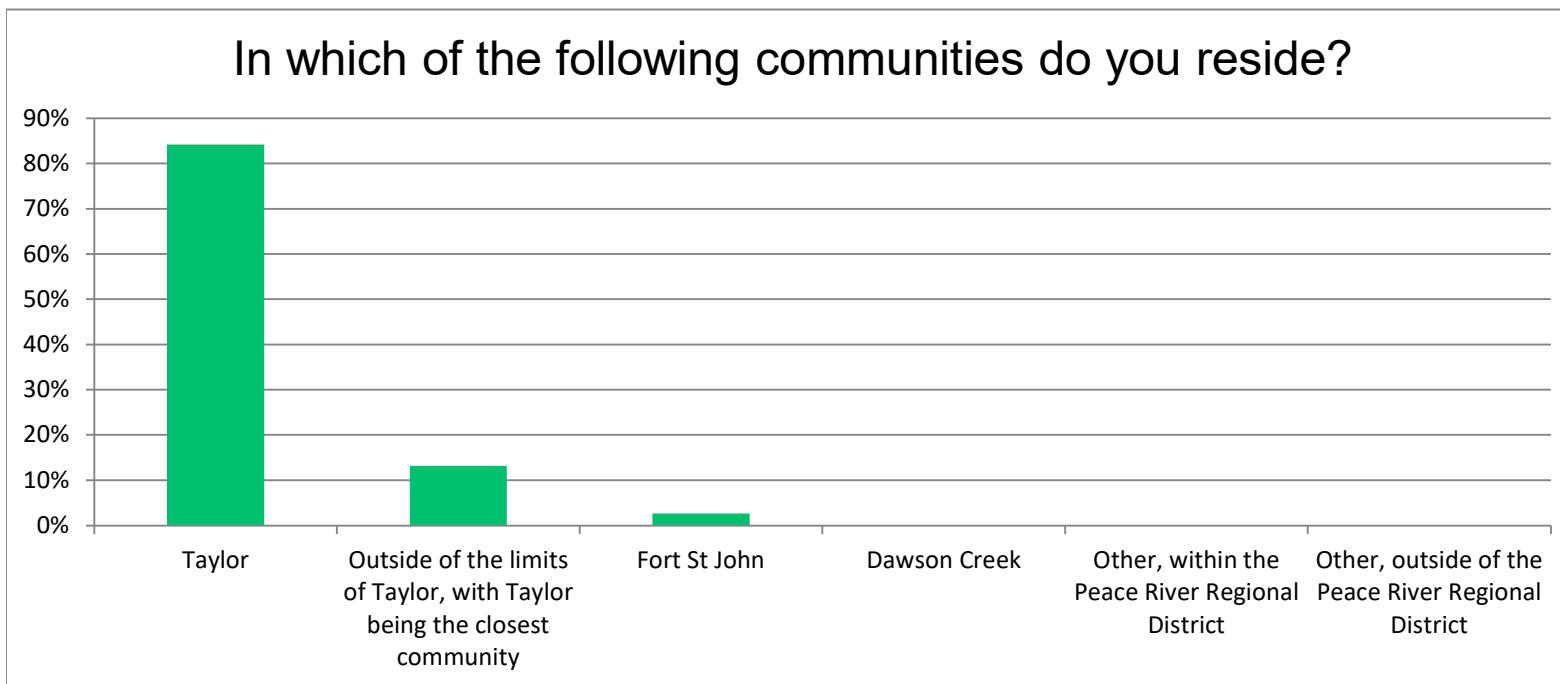

In which of the following communities do you reside?

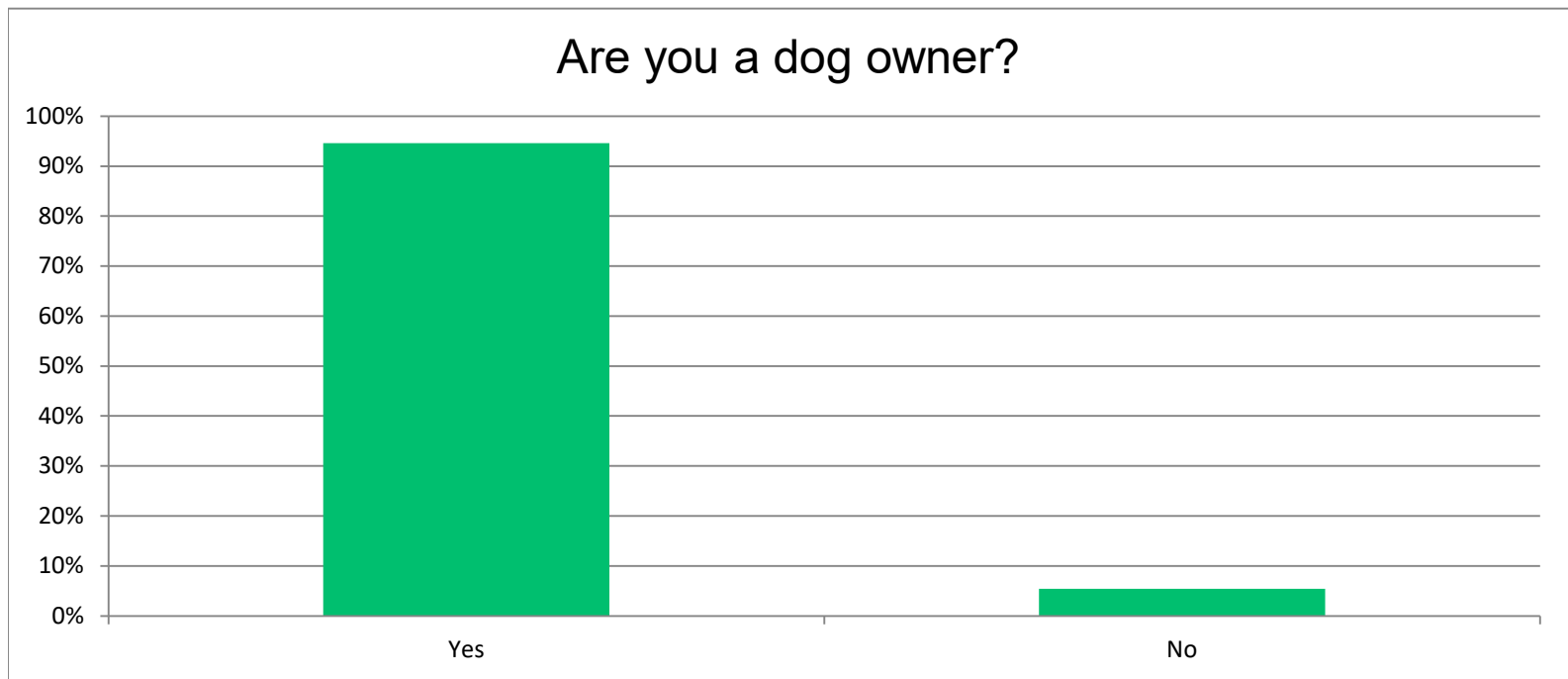

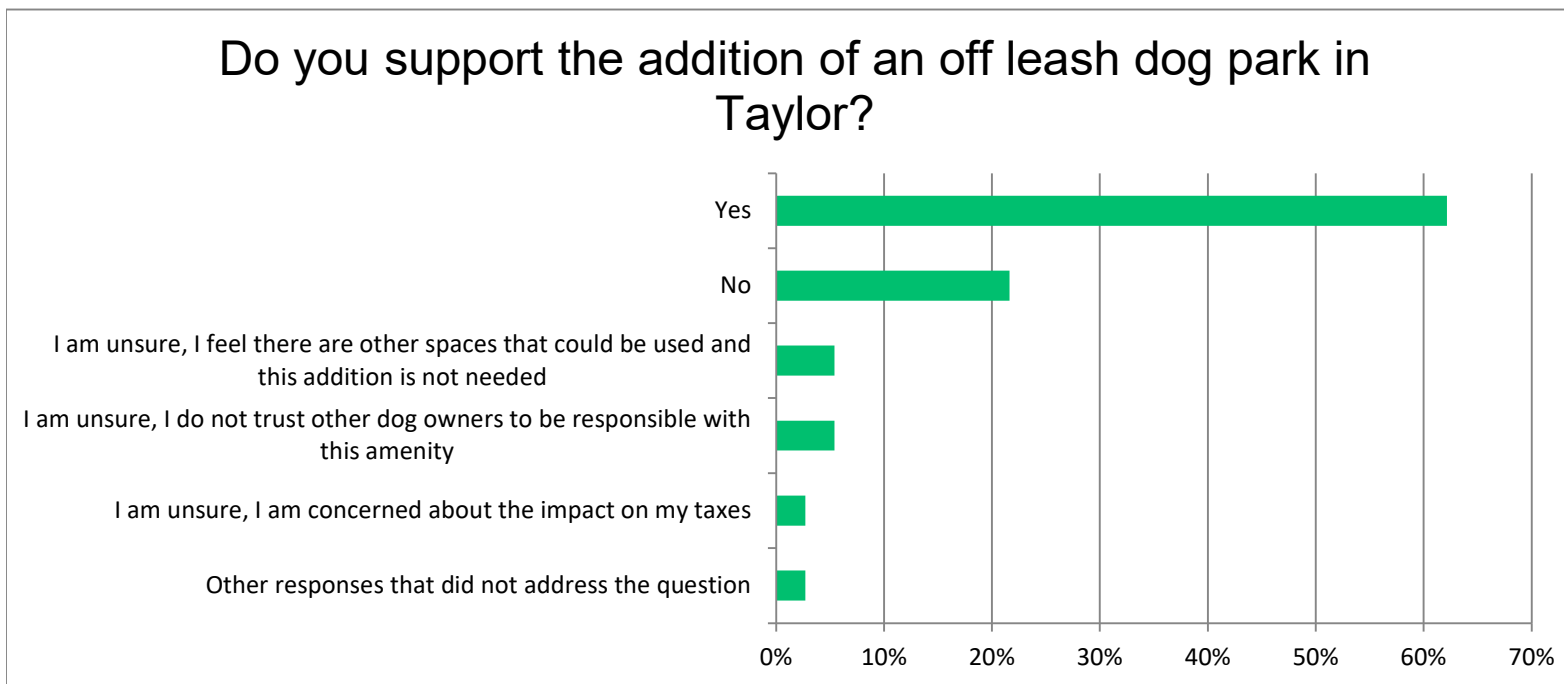

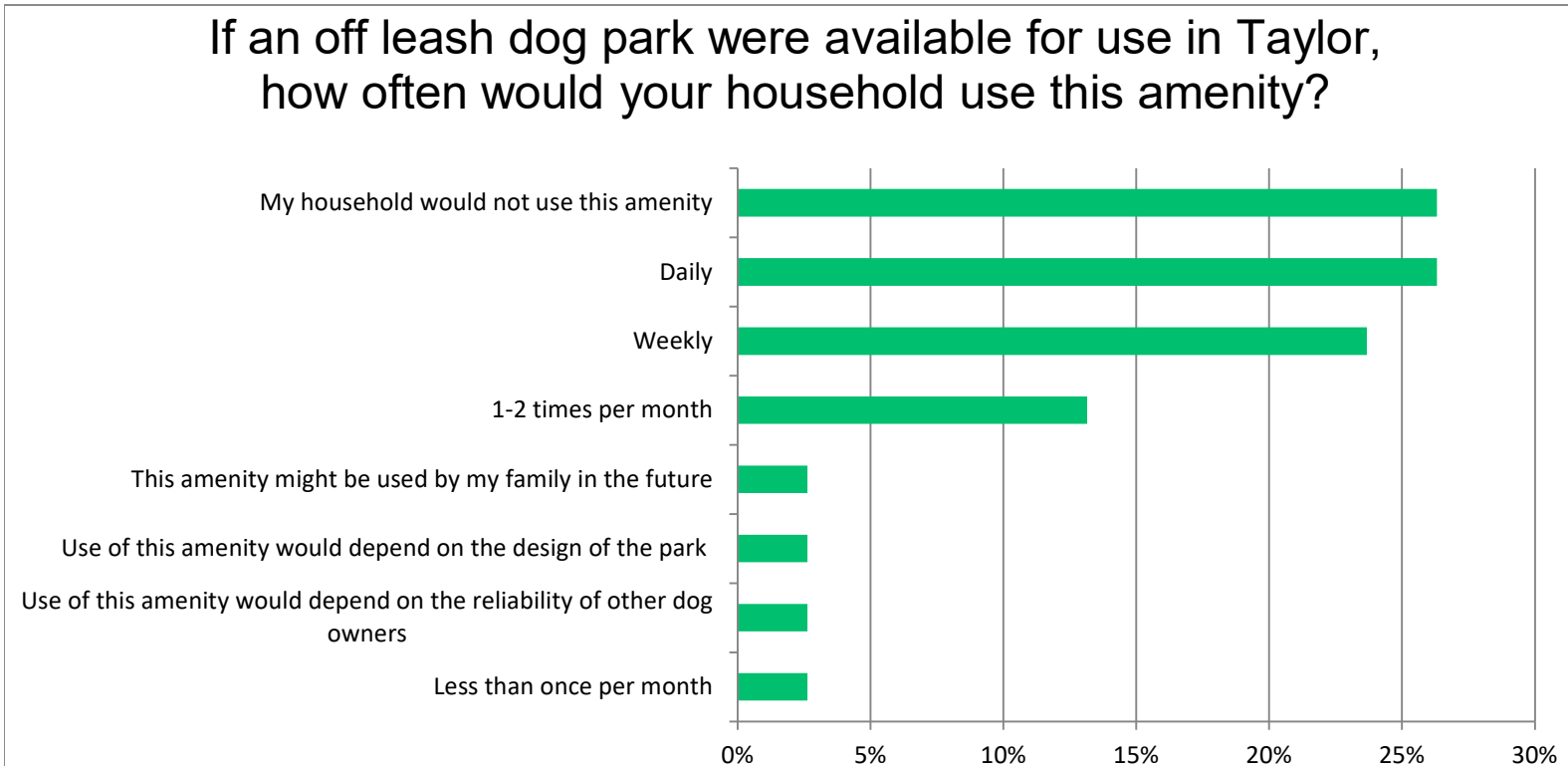

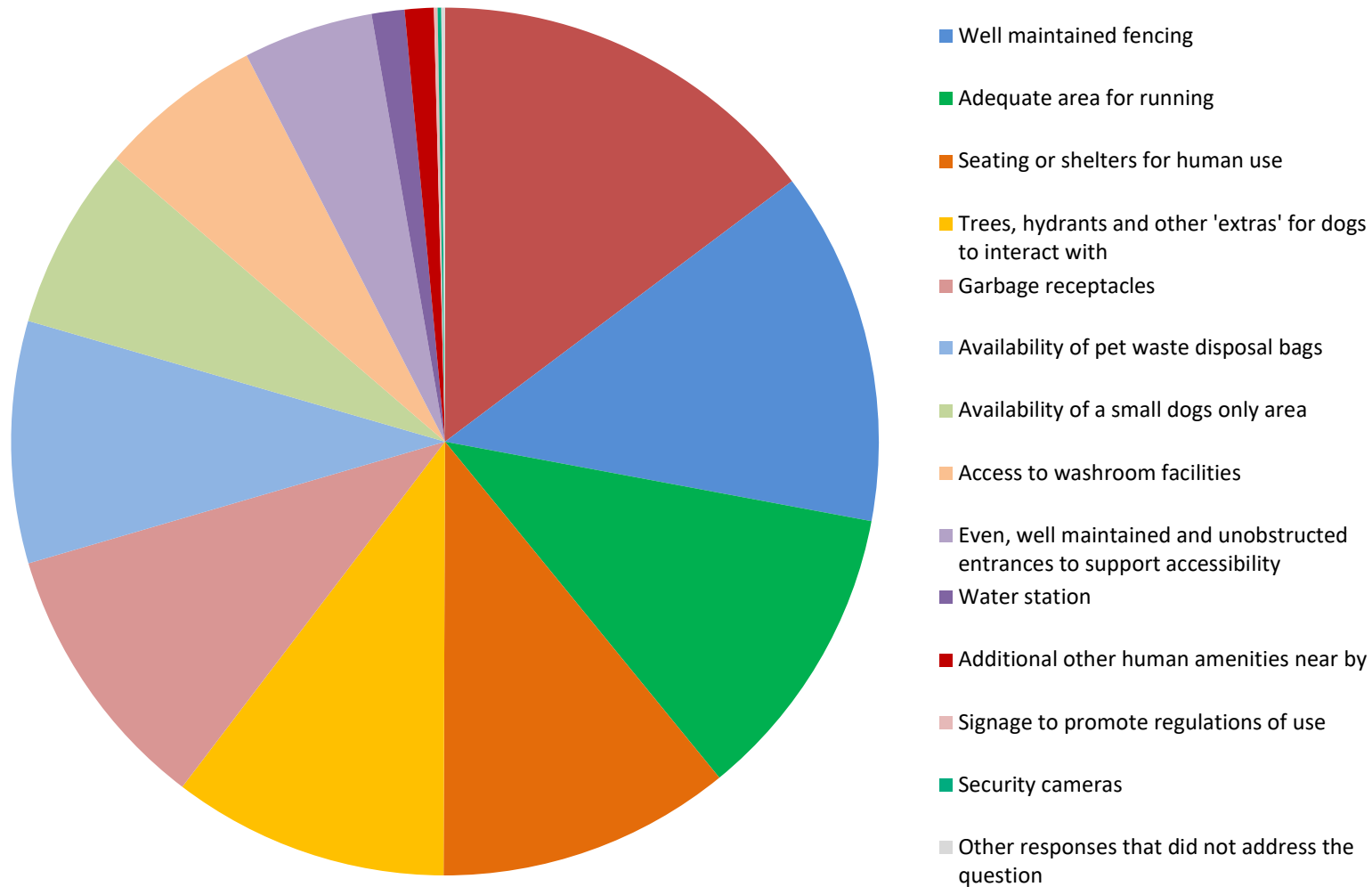

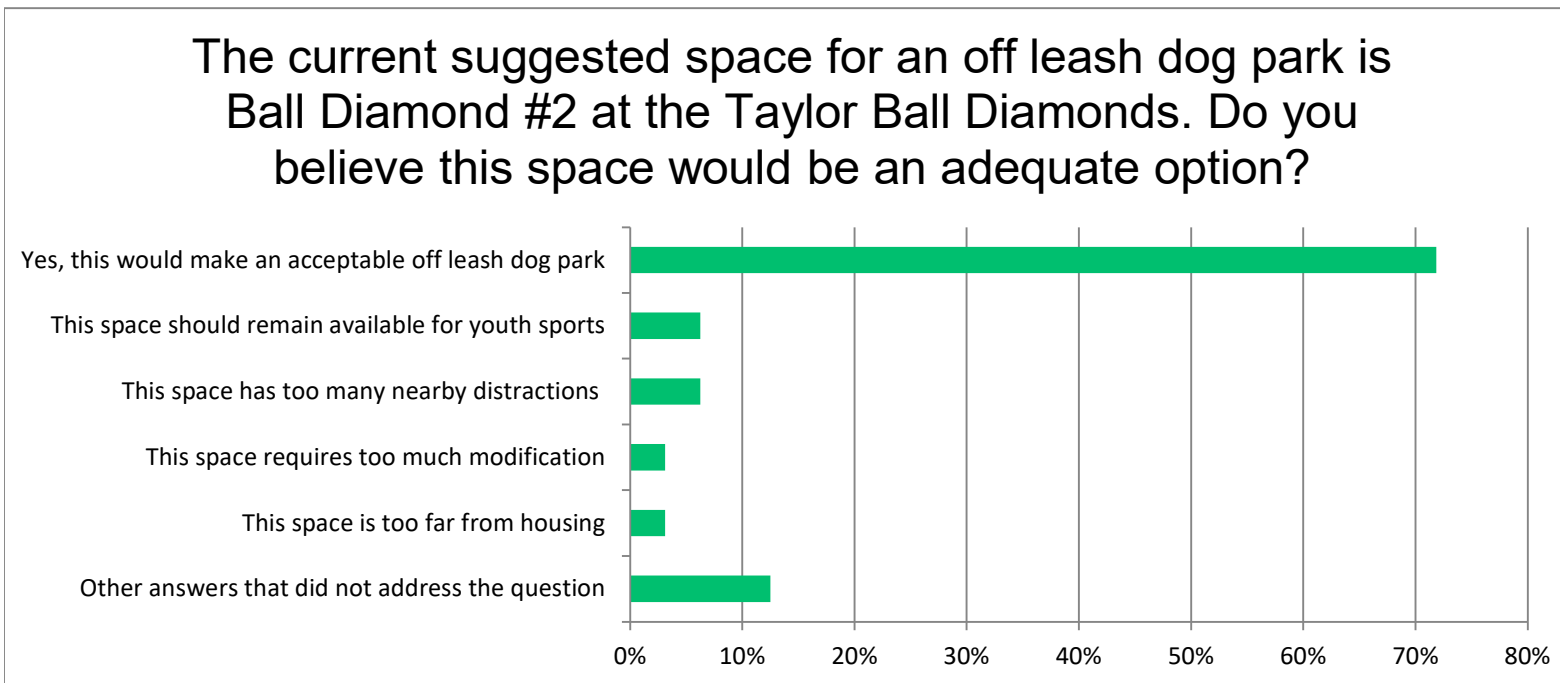

The current suggested space for an off leash dog park is Ball Diamond #2 at the Taylor Ball Diamonds. Do you believe this space would be an adequate option?

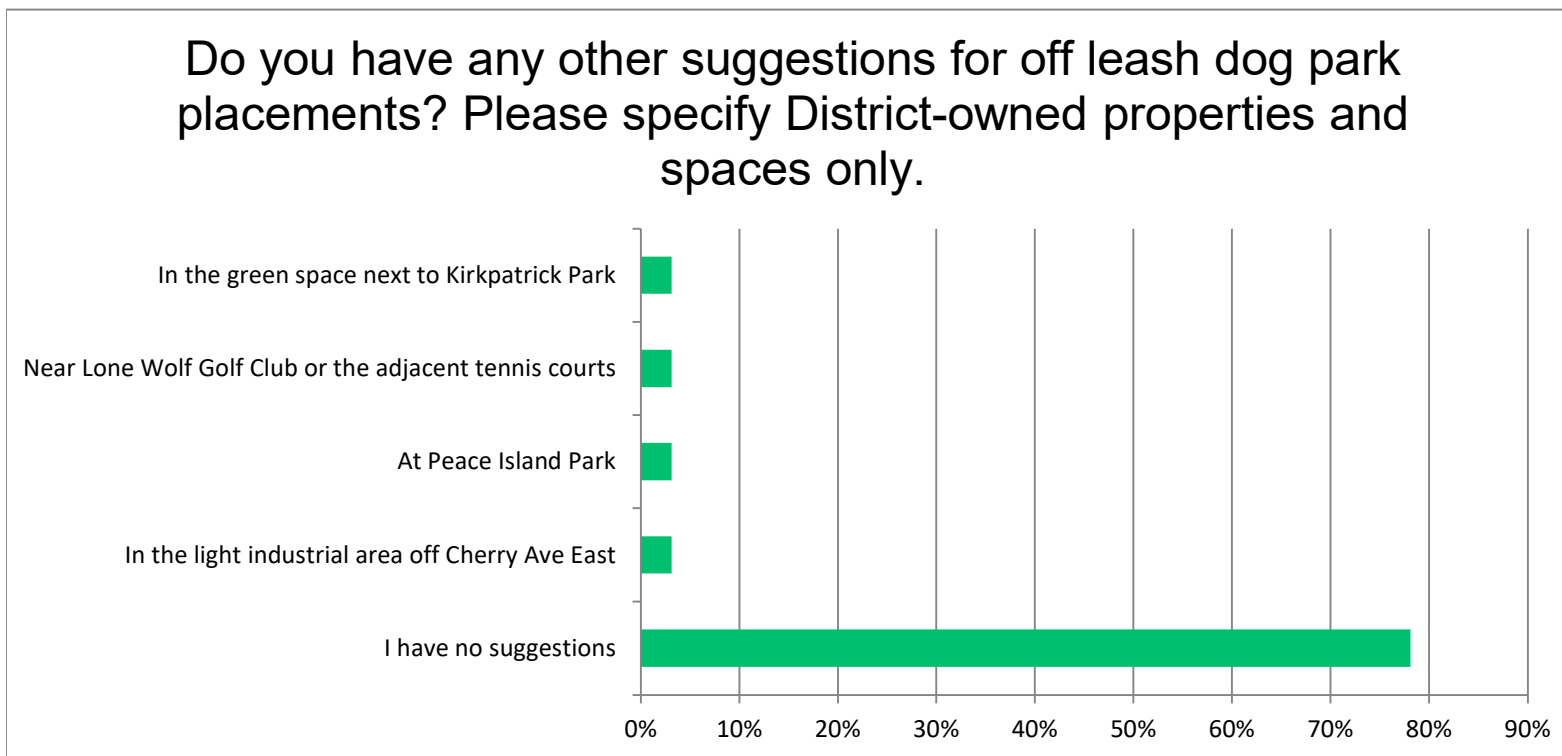

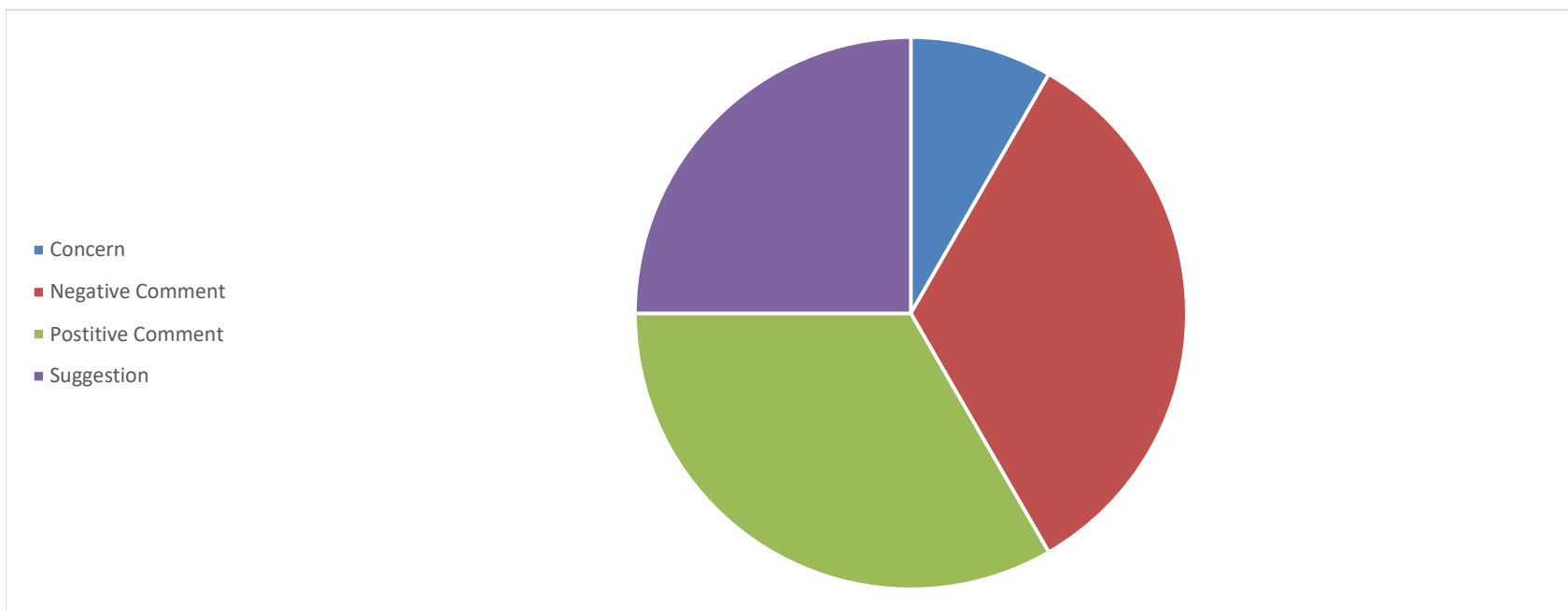

Taylor is surrounded by many easily accessible places to take pets for off leash activities. Using available space within the district for a dog park is unnecessary
